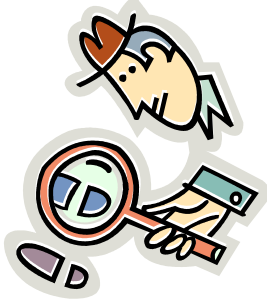
June 11-15, *Amazing Animals*, Grades 1-2: Learn about the wild kingdom with a week of animal crafts, stories, and real-life animals!

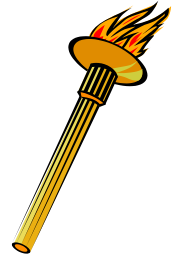
Every Child Ready To Read:
