21st Annual St. Patrick's Day Celebration March 17

Celtic dance and music will fill the Atrium of the Main Library on Monday, March 17, 12 noon for the Library's **21st Annual St. Patrick's Day Celebration**. The free event, sponsored by the Friends of the Public Library, will include music by Chazz Lite and dancing with the McGing Irish Dancers.

The McGing Irish Dancers have called Cincinnati their home for over 25 years, and have participated in the Library's St. Patrick's Day Celebration for the past 20 years. In addition to appearances in the tri-state area, they have also danced and competed across the country as well as overseas.

Chazz Lite is an eclectic music group that plays Irish and Scottish Celtic music using bagpipes, bodhran and other traditional instruments. They play sing-along music and ballads with a "New World" rock-n-roll flavor. The brainchild of Tom Scheidt of Time Machine Productions features Scheidt on guitar, bagpipes and vocals, and Kimberley G on vocals and percussion.
