### **23<sup>rd</sup> Annual Used Book Sale Sponsored by Anderson Library Committee Set for June 20-22 at Nagel Middle School 90,000 Books & Other Items Await You!**

There will be more books, more collectibles, and more selection than ever when the Anderson Library Committee hosts its **23<sup>rd</sup> Annual Used Book Sale** from Friday, June 20 through Sunday, June 22 at Nagel Middle School, 1500 Nagel Road (corner of State & Nagel Roads). Volunteers work year-round every Wednesday at a warehouse in the Eastgate area, sorting, pricing, repairing, and boxing thousands of books, CDs, videos, and cassettes in preparation for the sale. There will also be a limited number of collectibles and first editions, as well as some encyclopedia sets.

“There are so many area residents whose support helps the committee purchase books and other items for the Anderson and Mt. Washington Branch Libraries,” said Jean Sheppard, Book Sale Chair this year. “Many of the special programs at both branches are possible through the money raised at this book sale. None of this would be possible without the cooperation we get from many people—our core of volunteers, the Public Library, Forest Hills School District, and of course Greg Fischer, who allows us to store and sort our books all year long at no charge in his warehouse.

“Cookbooks and children’s books are always in demand and this year we have a great selection,” continued Mrs. Sheppard. Beautiful art books on the masters from Leonardo da Vinci to Norman Rockwell to Cincinnati talents, as well as handsome coffee table books, are some of the offerings.

“This year we will have more books than we have had in the past 22 years, about 90,000,” said Carol Roberto of the committee. “We have something for everyone’s tastes,

with bargains on used books, sets, CDs, cassettes, DVDs, videos, and books on tape. It's a great flea market atmosphere all under one roof, in the comfort of an air conditioned school, with plenty of free parking right outside the door," she said. "Generally, we mark items half price on Saturday afternoon," she added. There will also be a secret special going on all day Sunday. "You'll just have to show up and see what it is," she laughed.
