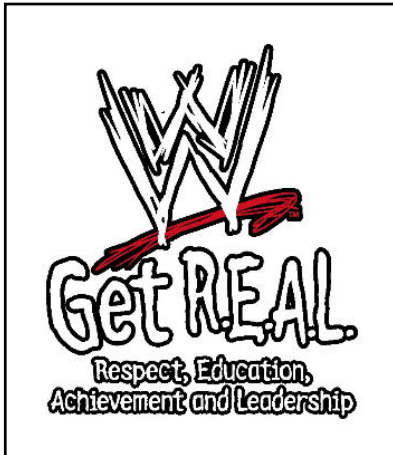

**Get R.E.A.L. as World Wrestling Entertainment Superstars Read to Kids at the Main Library on July 27!**  
Come meet World Wrestling Entertainment (WWE)

Superstars! Hear stories and ask questions of your favorite wrestlers! **The World Wrestling Entertainment Get R.E.A.L.** main event promises to be a total knock-out and is coming to the Main Library, 800 Vine Street, on Tuesday, July 27, 11:00 a.m. *Get R.E.A.L.* focuses on teaching respect, education, achievement and leadership.

World Wrestling Entertainment Superstars are often asked to speak to young people about their real lives--outside the ring--and what has helped them achieve their goals. They discuss their own personal histories, life challenges and achievements, and encourage people to resist peer pressure, avoid self-destructive behavior, and take advantage of their time in school to get an education.

As a result, World Wrestling Entertainment created *Get R.E.A.L.*, which brings WWE Superstars to deliver positive messages on education, literacy, safety and goal setting during the school year at junior and senior high schools. To promote learning when school is out, WWE created the *Get R.E.A.L.* summer reading program. Wrestlers will read selected stories and then participate in a question and answer period afterwards.
