You Can Register to Vote at any Hamilton County Library

Did you know that registering to vote is as easy as visiting your neighborhood library? For many years, the Public Library of Cincinnati & Hamilton County has been offering the service through the Hamilton County Board of Elections.

Voter registration forms are available year-round at all branch libraries and at the Main Library at the Circulation Services and Information Desks. These forms may be completed in the Library agency or can be mailed directly to the Board of Elections. Applications for Absentee Ballots are also available two to three months before an election, which should be mailed directly to the Board of Elections.

You are qualified to vote in the upcoming Presidential election if:

- You are a citizen of the United States.
- You are at least 18 years old on or before the day of the general election.
- You will be 18 on or before November 2, 2004, you may vote in the primary election for candidates, but not on issues.
- You will be a resident of Ohio for at least 30 days before the election.
- You register to vote by **Monday, October 4.**
