Jazz Up with Jazz of the Month Club at the Main Library

The Main Library (800 Vine Street) will get “jazzed up” on select Saturdays at 2:00 p.m. Beginning September 16, well-known jazz artists will perform in the Atrium as part of **The Jazz of the Month Club** series supported by internationally known saxophonist and a uthority on jazz education Jamey Aebersold, with additional support provided by the Friends of the Public Library.

Mr. Aebersold attended college at Indiana University and graduated in 1962 with a Masters Degree in Saxophone, but he also plays piano, bass and banjo. In 1992, he was awarded an Honorary Doctorate of Music by Indiana University. In 1989, the International

Association of Jazz Educators inducted Jamey into their Hall of Fame at the San Diego convention. With this award, Jamey joins other jazz luminaries such as Count Basie, Duke Ellington, Charlie Parker, Louis Armstrong and others.
