Kevin Frisch to Perform His Variety Show on October 19 **“Making Magic: Cincinnati’s Frisch Marionettes” on View** **at the Main Library October 7 – December 31**

To view this exhibit there may be some strings attached. The good news is they are tied to a fascinating world of intrigue. It’s the sort of intrigue that only the illustrious Frisch Marionette Company could stage. Founded in 1995 by puppeteer and artist Kevin Frisch, the company performs in the traditional style of the 19th century European puppetry with exquisitely custom-made marionettes, designed and handcrafted in their Cincinnati workshop.



From October 7 through December 31, the curtain’s going up to reveal a rare, behind-the-scenes look at “Making Magic: Cincinnati’s Frisch Marionettes.” On view at the Main Library of the Public Library of Cincinnati & Hamilton County, the exhibit (located in the Atrium of the south building) will focus on the process of creating a marionette from concept through completion. Sketches, prototypes, and fully-crafted marionettes, as well as images from Frisch Marionette shows, are part of the exhibit.

The marionettes have taken to the stage at the Cincinnati Opera and The Children’s Theatre of Cincinnati. They have taken to the screen in feature films and on television. But now they are ready for a different audience—those who are curious about the craft behind this master puppeteer, his company, and his ingenuity. To celebrate the launch of the exhibit, Kevin Frisch will perform his Variety Show in the Main Library’s Atrium on Sunday, October 19 at 2:00 p.m.

The Main Library, located at 800 Vine Street in downtown Cincinnati, is open Monday through Wednesday 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.; Thursday through Saturday 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.; and Sunday 1:00 to 5:00 p.m. Admission to the exhibit and performance are free.
