Paul G. Sittenfeld Appointed to Board of Library Trustees

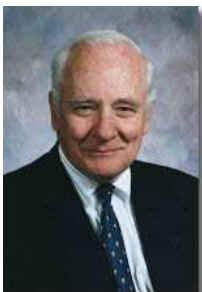
Paul G. Sittenfeld was appointed to the Board of Trustees of the Public Library of Cincinnati and Hamilton County by the Hamilton County Commissioners.

Mr. Sittenfeld is Managing Director/Portfolio Manager for Robert W. Baird and Company. A graduate of Princeton University with a master's degree from Occidental College in Los Angeles, Mr. Sittenfeld is an active volunteer locally and nationally with a special interest in educational institutions. He has served on the boards of St. Xavier High School, The Seven Hills School, Hebrew Union College, Xavier University, and Bethany College. A past Trustee of the Greater Cincinnati Foundation and the Anthem Foundation, he is currently a member of the Peterloom Foundation board, Cincinnati Parks Foundation, Shakertown in Kentucky, Chatfield College, and the Fund for Independent Schools of Cincinnati. Mr. Sittenfeld is a resident of East Walnut Hills.

Charles D. Lindberg Honored for 26 Years of Service as a Public Library Trustee



At its March 12 meeting, the Public Library Board of Trustees honored Charles D. Lindberg, who served on the Board for 26 years. In recognition of his outstanding commitment and service, the Board of Trustees conferred Mr. Lindberg with the lifetime honorary title of Trustee Emeritus of the Public Library of Cincinnati and Hamilton County.

Mr. Lindberg was first appointed to the Board of Library Trustees in 1982 by the Board of County Commissioners of Hamilton County. He served as President of the Board in 2007, 1996, and 1993, as well as several terms as Vice President and Secretary. He also served on the Administration Committee, the Books & Materials Committee, and the Finance & Audit Committee, which he chaired for many years.

Of counsel at the law firm of Taft, Stettinius & Hollister LLP, Mr. Lindberg also serves as Trustee of Knowlton Foundation and previously served on the Board of the Greater Cincinnati Chamber of Commerce and the Greater Cincinnati Center for Economic Development.

Mr. Lindberg, a graduate of the Yale Law School, was elected to the Cincinnati Board of Education from 1970–1974, and served twice as the President. He is a resident of Mt. Washington.
